

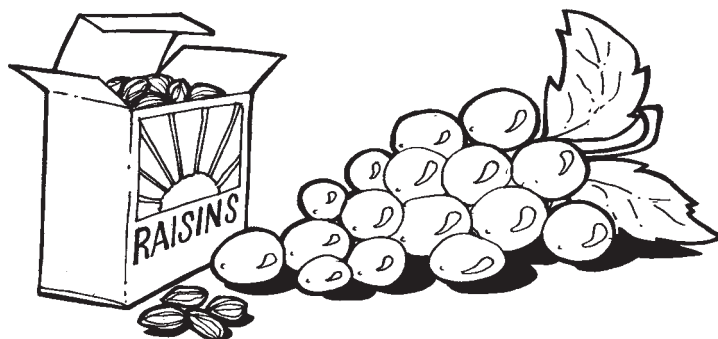
FROM GRAPES TO RAISINS

Do you know where raisins come from?

Try this and find out. You will need: seedless grapes, paper plate, paper towels, and tape



1. Wash a cluster of grapes; blot dry with paper towels.
2. Place grapes on a paper plate and cover with a paper towel with a few holes in it for ventilation.
3. Staple or tape paper plate and paper towel together along edges.
4. Place plate in direct sunlight and leave for 4-5 days.
5. Remove paper towels and enjoy your fresh raisins!
